Kennedy is an environmental activist and attorney who was named one of Time Magazine's "Heroes for the Planet" for his fight with Riverkeeper to restore New York's Hudson River. That group's work led to nearly 200 Waterkeeper organizations around the world, dedicated to preserving fishable, swimmable and drinkable waterways for future generations. Kennedy called Aspen a very forward thinking community with great energy idealism and commitment.
